Rockton Software is pleased to bring the utility Conditional Field Level Security to the Great Plains community. The purpose of this utility is to replace the Conditional Scripting feature introduced in Advanced Security for Great Plains version 7.0, but removed for version 8.0.

This software is intended for users who are familiar with Conditional FLS, and have used it in versions of Great Plains previous to version 8.0.

Installation

\*\*\*\*\*

For the first workstation:

1. Install the chunk file in the Great Plains directory.
2. Launch Great Plains. Select YES to include new code.
3. Log into Great Plains as 'sa'. Log into any company.

This will install tables automatically.

4. If you log into a non-test company, the registration window will open. You can enter your registration key.

For all other workstations:

1. Install the chunk file in the Great Plains directory.
2. Launch Great Plains. Select YES to include new code.

It is not necessary to install this product on every workstation.

The software will work without registration in the Great Plains test company. However, the registration window will open every time a user logs into a live company until the registration key is entered.

How to Use

When setting up Advanced Security, when viewing a Field Security ID in the Field Security Maintenance window, choose Extras >> Additional >> Conditional Security, or press Ctrl+C. The Conditional Field Level Security window will open. Check the box "Activate Conditional Field Security" if so desired, and enter a Dexterity script. The script must begin with an inout boolean parameter.

You can use the Names and Tables button to look up resources. When you are finished scripting, press the Check Syntax button to test your script for errors.

Press OK when you are finished editing the script. If you need to

disable the script but keep the script itself, you can uncheck the "Activate Conditional Field Security" checkbox without losing your script.
